

Funding Rules

III. Domestic Travel Grants for Collaborative Research by Postgraduate Students / Early Career Researchers

A. Eligibility

1. Postgraduate Students or Early Career Researchers (within 5 years of award of PhD degree) currently studying/working in Australia in the area of complex systems science.
2. COSNet Participants.
3. Visiting a location within Australia for collaborative research.
4. Documented support from Supervisor and collaborating researcher.

B. Conditions of funding

1. From \$1,000 to \$5,000 for travel and accommodation to a location within Australia, depending on the length of visit.
2. Maximum direct funding to any COSNet Participant should not exceed \$5,000 per year.
3. Co-funding amounts at least equal to COSNet funding are expected from Applicant's home institution or other sources.
4. Must acknowledge funding support from COSNet and the ARC in all publications that result from the visit.
5. Must provide COSNet with a [Funded Activity Report](#) stating the outcomes within two months of completion of the visit.

C. Payment of funding support

1. Payment of funding support will be made as reimbursement to the institution that incurs the initial costs.
2. After the visit, the institution is requested to issue a tax invoice to COSNet, attaching a statement by the funding recipient that the visit has taken place.

D. Application procedure

1. Applications using the [Application Form for Domestic Travel Grant for Collaborative Research \(by Postgraduate Students / ECRs\)](#) should be submitted at least two months before the event.
2. All applications must satisfy the listed conditions of funding. Where it is necessary to rank applications, because the requested funds exceed those available, this ranking will be done on the basis of which applications best fit COSNet's aims and best satisfy its funding rules. There is no appeals process. The decisions made by the COSNet Management Committee will be final.

3. Upon receiving notification of the results of their applications, successful Applicants must acknowledge their understanding and acceptance of the specific terms and conditions of the funding, before funds can be accessed.

E. Summary of post-event obligations

1. Provide COSNet with a Funded Activity Report stating the outcomes of the activity within two months of the visit.
2. Ask your home institution to issue a tax invoice to COSNet, attaching a personal statement that the visit has taken place.
3. Acknowledge funding support from COSNet and the ARC in all publications that result from the visit.
